Project objective

The SIGA project goal is to develop an educational programme for the elderly on the use of medicinal wild plants with an emphasis on preserving the habitat of wild plants. Through the developed programme, the elderly will gain knowledge on how to properly collect medicinal wild plants and how to use these plants to make herbal preparations for health preservation and disease prevention. The elderly will get the chance to actively contribute to their local communities while spending quality time in nature, learning and mastering new skills, raising environmental awareness and caring for their own health.

The key results that will be achieved:
